



KONTIKI FIRETABLE INSTALLATION

Congratulations on the purchase of your new Kontiki Fire Table! This table is built with light weight Glass Fiber Reinforced Concrete (GFRC) to allow mobility. Being hand-crafted, no two products will be exactly alike; these product finishes are created through a combination of color, solids, mixing processes and curing times as well as conditions, to create a unique outcome for your finished piece. Enclosed is an information envelope with an Owner's Manual on the certified match lit fire table burner, lighting instructions and gas valve information. The following information provides you with the dis-assembly of the packaging, assembly of your fire table and maintenance of your new Kontiki Fire Table.

Fire Table Assembly

Unpacking:

- Carefully remove top and sides of crate and remove packing
- Review the enclosed burner operations instructions to determine the best location for your fire table

Assembly:

- Lift your fire table to your desired location, this may require more than one person
- Under the table you will find the gas extension hose and fire glass. Enclosed in your information package is the ignition key for your fire table
- Ensure all gas connections to propane tanks or home connections are handled by a professionally certified gas specialist.
- For further assembly follow the instructions in the installation and operation manual provided in your product package

Fire Table Care and Maintenance

Cleaning and Maintenance:

- To clean your fire table use a solution of gentle dish soap and warm water, rinse, and dry with soft non-abrasive cloth.
- Depending on the weather conditions and exposure of the fire table, possible refinishing over time may be required to maintain the luster of the table finish. Contact the nearest Build Direct representative for details of necessary products to refinish.
