CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Maintaining the look of your patio umbrella is simple and easy. Clean your umbrella frame with a clean, damp cloth. If heavy cleaning is required, use mild soap and water and then wipe with a clean cloth afterwards. Harsh or toxic cleaners may damage the finish of the frame and are not recommended.

Your umbrella shade is made from durable Sunbrella fabrics, but should be kept clean from dirt and debris and should be spot cleaned regularly to delay the necessity of deep or rigorous cleaning. A hose, mild soap and water will take care of cleaning needs. Allow your umbrella to dry completely before storing.

Do not leave your umbrella base full of water in the winter months and do not stand on your umbrella base at any time. This could cause permanent damage.

Your patio umbrella is designed to provide shade and a cool area to relax. It is not designed to withstand high winds, rainstorms or hurricanes. Storage away from the elements is necessary to keep your umbrella in the best condition. Ensure your umbrella is completely clean and dry, and store it in a garage or dry storage space. If storing outdoors in dry weather, an umbrella cover is recommended to increase the longevity and look of your umbrella shade and frame.
