

Installation and Maintenance Guidelines GLASS TILE

Please inspect tiles before installation. Use of the product by the purchaser constitutes acceptance and no claims will be accepted after material is worked, damaged, cut or installed.

Hire a qualified professional installer for your project to ensure proper installation.

Cosmopolitan recommends the use of Mapei (www.mapei.com) and Laticrete (www.laticrete.com) setting products, and Tenax products (www.tenaxusa.com) for stone sealing and care. Follow all manufacturer guidelines and instructions to ensure proper installation and/or usage.

Glass Tile

Installation: Use of high quality latex modified thin set, or setting materials specifically designated for use with fused pigment (color on back) glass, is recommended. Mastic is not appropriate for installation of glass tile. Be sure to back-butter completely! DO NOT USE V NOTCH TROWEL

Grout: NON SANDED (to avoid scratching)

Cutting: Cut tiles with a wet saw using a diamond blade designed specifically to cut glass tile. For very small cuts, a mechanical score and snap cutter can be used. It is required to score both sides of the tile (front and back) as the tiles are produced using two fused glass layers. Any rough edges after cutting or snapping can be smoothed with an emery cloth.

Maintenance: Use any standard household cleaner recommended and/or safe to use on glass surfaces.
